Some riders wait to join the peloton in Beal, Birkin Church. And some riders join the Groupetto at Birkin cafe. All members finishing back at Birkin cafe for refreshments at the end of the different group rides. The Tuesday night group ride some members describe is a cracking ride and its getting better, one member last week did her personal best and said she found it easier. THE DAYS/NIGHTS ARE GETTING DARKER The Tuesday Evening 6pm Ride with BBM Nibbles at Birkin – The Tuesday evening 6.30 ride with nibbles has been enjoyed throughout the summer, but due to darker nights the ladies have started meeting at 6pm. The ride groups merging back at the cafe for drinks & food has been well attended and enjoyed. Thanks go to Lou & Dave East for volunteering to do the drinks during the summer. Thursday Evening faster group ride – 6.30 KRUFc . Aprox one dozen riders meet regularly to do a fifty mile ride which they organise between them. b.. GO RIDE Go ride had a break during the summer holidays when the school was closed but will start again on Monday 11th September at 7pm. A Satellite Club is being formed at the BKCAT circuit to encourage inactive school children to become more active through cycling. David has agreed to coach an early group session for four weeks with children after school on Monday evenings prior to our Go ride session, hopefully these will feed into our go ride 7pm groups. The club has been promised £3,000 from Yorkshire Sport foundation which will be given in two payments half in September 2017 and half in six months time.
